



## **2012 Pfizer Animal Health Veterinary Student Scholarship Criteria**

Pfizer Animal Health will be awarding up to 300 veterinary student scholarships at \$2,500 each in 2012. The scholarships will be administered by the American Veterinary Medical Foundation (AVMF).

In order for a student to be considered for a scholarship in 2012, he or she must meet the minimum eligibility requirements, as outlined below, and submit a completed application at [www.vetstudentconnect.com](http://www.vetstudentconnect.com) or [www.avmf.org/pfizer](http://www.avmf.org/pfizer) no later than November 30, 2011.

This scholarship is open to all veterinary students in their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of attendance at an AVMA-accredited college of veterinary medicine in the United States or the Caribbean, regardless of their course of study and future career ambitions. Previous applicants and scholarship winners may also apply, as long as they meet the criteria.

### ***The following will be taken into account when reviewing applications:***

- Academic Excellence
- Leadership
- Diversity
- Sustainability of the veterinary profession

### ***Minimum Student Requirements***

- Student must be currently enrolled, and in good standing, at one of the U.S. or Caribbean-based AVMA-accredited schools of veterinary medicine
- Student must be currently in their 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of veterinary school
- Student must be a member of the Student AVMA (SAVMA)
